- The Illinois Contract System (iCS) is the new, web-based contract management system for the University of Illinois.
- University contracts may be developed, routed, reviewed, approved, executed, and stored within iCS.
- It serves as the electronic repository for all fully executed University contracts.



# iCS Advantages

- Reduces and/or eliminates paper copies
- Web-based access
- Versioning
- Eliminates physical University signatures
- Workflow Tracking
- Generates Reports
- Advanced Searches
- Audit Trail
- Historical information
